digitally enabled cashless economic system. The seminar shared the objective to create awareness among the villagers and familiarize them with the modes of cashless payments.

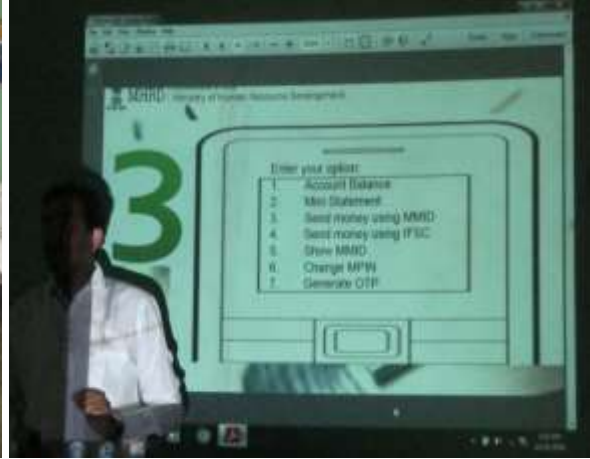
